## **OBJECTIVES & AIMS:**

- 1. Inform and raise awareness about environmental and wildlife crime.
- 2. Inform and raise awareness about **environmental liability** for preventing and remediating biodiversity damage.
- 3. Change the attitude of stakeholders, targeted audience and lay public in Crete that their support and engagement in EU environmental law enforcement is an important tool to protect biodiversity and support local development and social cohesion.
- 4. Provide stakeholders and target audiences with the appropriate skills for being engaged in effective prosecution procedure regarding wildlife crime, for requiring measures for the remediation of biodiversity damage and for integrating biodiversity issues in regional and local policy.
- 5. Communicate regarding the role and **importance of the implementation of EU environmental legislation** in human well-being in NATURA 2000 (N2000) Network to other N2000 site managers in Greece.

## **MAIN PROJECT ACTIONS:**

The **main project actions** and means involved to reach the project objectives were:

- Establishment of 2 Environmental Law Observatories, in East and West Crete, respectively.
- Awareness raising activities such as workshops, conferences and Application for Smart Devices.
- Training Seminars to develop specific skills to stakeholders.
- Production of 4 Technical Guides.
- Usage of project website and local media as tools towards environmental awareness.
- ❖ Development of indicators for the evaluation of the project effectiveness.

## **Environmental Law Observatories**

The 2 Environmental Law Observatories are innovative structures that were created within the framework of the LIFE Natura Themis project and are being implemented by 2 Bar Associations of Crete (CB & HB, respectively).

- ✓ Environmental Law Observatory (ELO) in East Crete started in September 2016 and it is in full operation since January 2017. It is being operated by the Heraklion Bar Association (HB).
- ✓ Environmental Law Observatory (ELO) in West Crete started in September 2016 and it is in full operation since November 2016. It is being operated by the Chania Bar Association (CB).
- Every 4 months, the team of both ELOs checks and registers all published bills, acts, laws, technical regulations, ministerial or administrative decisions, and public contracts referring to direct or indirect environmental management of the NATURA 2000 protected areas of Crete.
- In addition, analysis and compilation of cases already registered take place.
- Contacts with stakeholders, targeted audiences and local community are made on a permanent basis.

The database with registered environmental cases that both ELOs collect is connected with the official website of the project, in where they are presented in a geo-information map.

The geo-information map shows the prosecuting cases for wildlife crimes that are taking place within the NATURA 2000 protected areas of Crete.

- The marking of sites is done approximately (due to restrictions of the General Data Protection Regulation [GDPR]).
- In order to ensure the confidentiality and protection of perpetrators' personal data, a permit has been obtained from the competent Personal Data Protection Authority.
- The communicated information is kept in written form at UoC NHMC.
- Environmental crimes and violations are posted without reference to the accused / perpetrator, following a review of criminal records of pre-investigation services and court decisions.



















It is believed that the geo-information map opens a new era in the field of prosecution, prevention and repression of "green" crime, since it may assists in the:

- ✓ better planning of environmental auditing;
- ✓ qualitative and quantitative assessment of green crime;
- ✓ prediction of green crime's commission;
- ✓ interdepartmental cooperation in law enforcement; and
- ✓ sensitization of local communities and effective case prosecution.
- ✓ Especially if used in combination or supplementary with the Application's map for anonymous complaints (LIFE THEMIS Application, see next slides), which generally seems to coincide in terms of the characterization of the "crime hotspots", it will multiply the effectiveness of preventing and suppressing environmental crimes and/or violations.

## **Smart Devices Application (LIFE Themis APP)**

In the framework of LIFE Natura Themis project, an **Application for Smart Devices** (mobiles, tablets, etc.) was created for facilitating citizens to report an environmental crime.

The use of such a tool was deemed necessary as citizens avoid reporting incidents of environmental degradation or environmental crime for 3 basic reasons, e.g.

- Fear of retaliation or targeting, if they make a personal complaint.
- Money and time spent for the complaint.
- Involvement with authorities, police and/or courts.

The Application gives citizens the to report an environmental crime anonymously, in real time and with all necessary details:

- exact place of the crime (use of device's geo-reference system, mandatory);
- evidence with photographs (mandatory) or text (optional).

## Smart Devices Application (LIFE Themis APP) (2/5)

- ✓ Fully functional since August 2017; freely available and covers only Crete, Greece.
- √ 552 Users have downloaded the App.; 207 of them are active (147 Android / 60 iOS)
- ✓ More than 250 reports have been received so far.
- √ 176 Reports were valid and forwarded to competent authorities.
- ✓ 26 Cases has been successfully dealt with and the damage was restored.
- ✓ A fine of €2,000.00 was imposed in one of these reports.
- ✓ In 2 reports, the cases reached the Courts or the perpetrator was identified.

## Invalid reports are mainly due to:

- position inaccuracy due to poor connection of the device to satellites;
- inaccuracy in depicting a crime (photos of bad quality or pictures captured far from the crime's place or controversial illustration of the problem);
- irrelevant violation with an environmental crime (e.g. photos from waste outside bins);
- > clear intent to deceive (reports with photos from internet and geolocation from users' house!).















## **Technical characteristics:**

- ✓ Available in Greek and in English.
- ✓ Compatible with Android and iOS devices.
- ✓ QR Code availability.
- ✓ Required memory space for installation: 4.2 MB.
- ✓ Friendly user's interface.
- ✓ Availability for offline report if internet connection is not available.

## **Complaint steps:**

- ✓ Initially, the georeference system of the user's device needs to be activated.
- ✓ Following the instructions, the user takes photos of the problem he/she wishes to report (up to 4 photos).
- ✓ The user can write a relevant comment or text with possible keywords that briefly describe the violation (e.g. debris disposal, seafront degradation, etc.).
- ✓ The user sends his message automatically.
- ✓ When there is no internet access, the application saves the complaint on the device and the sending is completed automatically when there is an internet connection.
- ✓ The georeference of the violation's point is done automatically by the positioning system of the user's device.





















## Back office support and administration (1/2):

The Application is **supported with a server**, where each complaint is registered automatically in a database (free software MySQL).





















## Back office support and administration (2/2): It has support on a separate website (programming language PHP), with a visible side and an administration panel, which is not open to public.

## **Administrators of the Application:**

- > Receive the reports.
- > Compare the correctness of data (e.g. exact location, clear photos, image matching with exact infringement / crime) & decide if report is valid or not.
- ➤ Contact the user in order to inform him/her about the report's process (the message is between the Application's platform server and the user's registered application-device, not in his/her telephone number or online connection like SMS or other, meaning that the user has to visit his App to see if someone responded in the report).
- ➤ Decide which are the appropriate competent authorities for each report, depending on the type of infringement/crime and the location of the event.
- > Send a relevant letter with the complaint.
- Receive replies from authorities.
- > Keeps a detailed record of events (users' reports and authorities' replies).
- > Processes the data and disseminate the results.

## Advantages and use of the Application by the State/Authorities:

- The operation of the application was carried out on a pilot basis only for the needs of the project, for a specific period of time and for a specific area.
- With the appropriate adjustment, it can be used in any region or country with low cost.
- With this tool, authorities can have any report of environmental crime in real time, with all the necessary data they need, e.g. photos with the violation, exact position and geolocation of the incident, etc.
- That means that they can act immediately, saving time, man-power and resources.
- With the immediate activation of the authorities, the chances of locating the perpetrator increase dramatically.
- The effectiveness of the prosecution can be improved.
- Potential offenders will be more reluctant to commit an offense, if they know that someone can record them and trigger prosecution immediately.
- State and authorities can improve their planning of environmental control.
