Wild life crime - Slovenia













Wild Life Crime

Unlawful Handling of Protected Animals and Plants Article 344

Whoever illegally possesses, seizes, damages, kills, exports, imports or trades in protected wild animal or plant species, or their parts, or products made therefrom, shall be punished by imprisonment of up to five years.

If the object is of major or exceptional nature protection significance, or if the act was committed within a criminal association for the commission of such criminal offences, the perpetrator shall be punished by imprisonment of not less than six months and not more than ten years.

Wild Life Crime

The Police detects wild life crime:

- On the basis of applications or its own findings;
- In most cases while inspecting vehicles;
- Mainly in relation to illegal import or export of protected animals, especially dead specimen of birds (illegal transportation from Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina to Italy).

Slovenia is mostly a transit country.











Wild Life Crime

The Police has not detected any special pattern or period in which there would be more criminal offenses.

Actions against wildlife crime

- Slovenia implemented CITES in the year 2000;
- CITES protects over **150** species, which live in Slovenia (bear, wolf, peregrine falcon, Nigritella rhellicani, ordinary bell, cyclamen ...);
- Slovenian Customs authorities every year discover also many cases of illegal imports of:

- land turtles, - caviar,

- date mussel, - ivory.

- coral,

Most CITES specimens are seized at the airport.











Actions against wildlife crime

- Slovenia participated in the IMPEL project "Hunting tourism" in 2016 and 2017;
- Regarding wildlife trafficking, the Inter-agency Working Group is working at the national level:
 - including Police, environmental inspection, Customs and management authorities with support of the scientific authorities (Institute of RS for Nature Conservation).

Environmental Liability Directive – ELD (Directive 2004/35/EC)



It is based on the

"POLLUTER-PAYS PRINCIPLE"

The polluters that have caused environmental damage or an imminent threat of such damage are liable for implementing the necessary preventive and remediation actions and paying for their costs.











Environmental Liability Directive

The Directive defines "environmental damage" as damage to:

- protected species and natural habitats,
- damage to water and
- damage to soil.

Environmental damage - the negative change in a natural resource must be **measurable** & damage must be assessed as **significant**!

Who can be liable? - any natural or legal, private or public person who operates or controls the occupational activity











Environmental Liability Directive

STRICT LIABILITY

Operators involved in **dangerous** occupational activities (listed in Annex III of the ELD)

These operators can be held liable for damage to:

- Protected species and natural habitats
- Water
- Land

These operators can be held liable even without having to establish their fault or negligence





FAULT-BASED LIABILITY

Operators involved in **all other** occupational activities

These operators can be held liable only for damage to:

 Protected species and natural habitats

Fault or **negligence** needs to be established for the operator to be held liable

- Identify the shortcomings in the implementation of the ELD in Slovenia and prepare suggestions for improvements;

- Assist in the development of ELD specific insurance policy;
- Transfer good practice from abroad.


2. Collection of environmental legislation

- A detailed explanation of the content and requirements of the Environmental Liability Directive.












3. Environmental guide



Sector-specific toolkit, which will describe requirements of the environmental legislation.

Each individual user will get:

- description of rights and obligations by which he is bound and
- some useful tips regarding how to act.











4. Risk assessment tool



The main purpose of this tool is to provide users with an assessment of their risks of causing environmental damage.

It will be available as an interactive application.

Users will receive the key information for managing their environmental and financial risks.
