






2005: these two poisoned IEs were found

Mortality causes of imperial eagle in Hungary between 1980-2004 (n=45)



Mortality causes of imperial eagle in Hungary between 2005-2016 (n=166)





- Biggest threat for strictly protected Imperial Eagles: illegal predator poisoning
- between 2000-2018:
 - 1824 poisoned victims (birds and mammals) found 1559 protected species
 - 234 eagles: 142 White-tailed eagles, 88 Imperial eagles, 3 Golden eagles, 1 Lesser spotted eagle



- To find poisoned birds and poisonous baits: reported and random field searches
- House searches during the investigative phase
- Prevention










Poisoned <u>protected</u> birds and mammals in Hungary between 2006 - 2017

Outcomes of the bird crime cases in the Pannonian region in year 2017



Verdicts:

- sentenced in 4 cases:
- Professional hunter 3 marsh harriers – small financial penalty €300
- 2 professional hunter 2 imperial eagles + 1 marsh harrier – financial penalty €4000
- Professional hunter Several stuffed birds – 1 year 3 months (suspended for 2 years) and € 2400
- Duck farmer 14 buzzards -1 year
 7 months (suspended for 3 years)
- Some case on going...
